General:

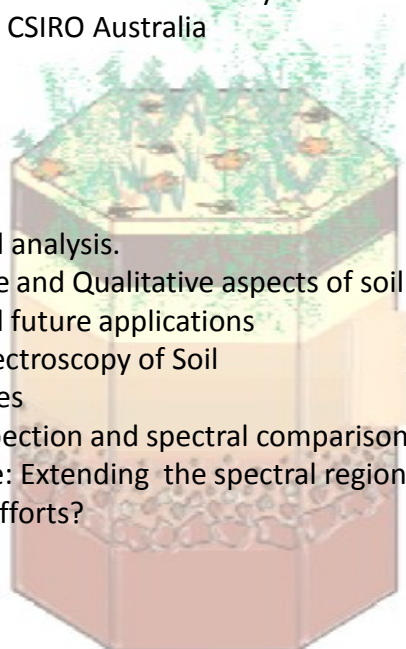
