

## Research assistant (20%)

Dr. Govinda Clayton and Dr. Enzo Nussio, senior researchers at the Center for Security Studies at ETH Zurich, are looking to recruit a research assistant with experience working with geographic data in a project funded by the Swiss National Science Foundation. In this role the research assistant will be responsible for creating datasets and visualizations on social dynamics in Latin America and specifically Mexico, to help in a project on community violence. The person should have experience working with geographic data, creating visualizations, have a good command of English, and have some knowledge of Spanish. This will be a 20% position (approx. 29 CHF an hour), initially on a 6 month contract. Only students enrolled at a Swiss university are eligible for this position.
