

Governing the earth: Earth system governance and political geography in the Anthropocene

Summary/Zusammenfassung

This project seeks to explore how the concept of the Anthropocene has been taken up within policy-oriented environmental governance discourses, notably by the Earth System Governance Project (ESG), to reframe the objectives of environmental governance. The project seeks to unpack the political consequences of a governmental imaginary in which the Earth system is considered an object of governance. I was awarded a Forschungskredit research grant from the University of Zurich to pursue this research under the title 'Governing the Earth: Earth System Governance and Political Geography in the Anthropocene'.
