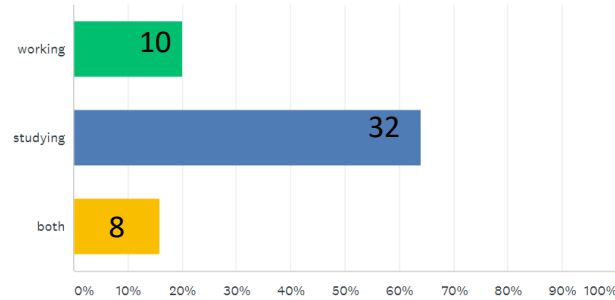

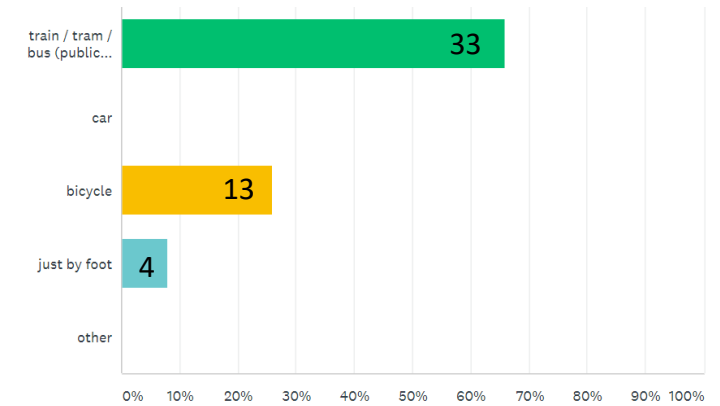

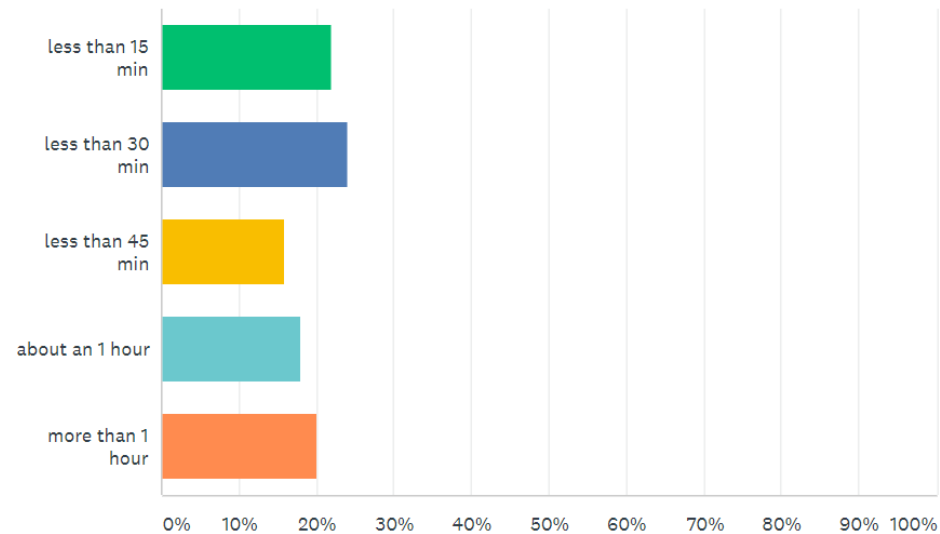
What means of transport do you use for your commute to Irchel Campus?

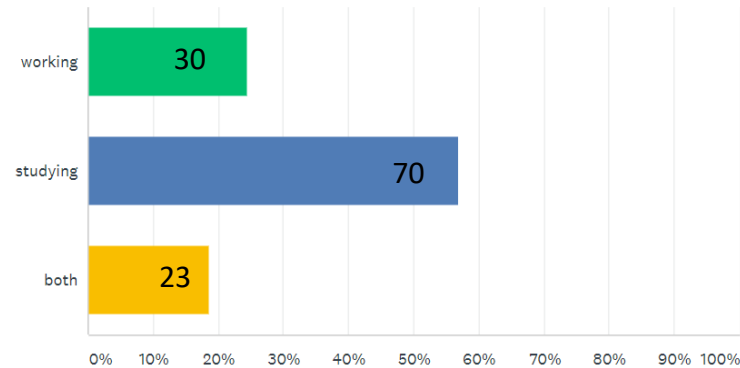

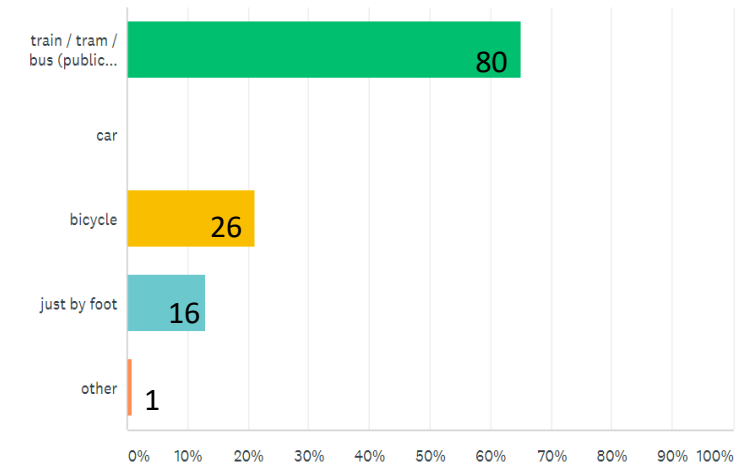

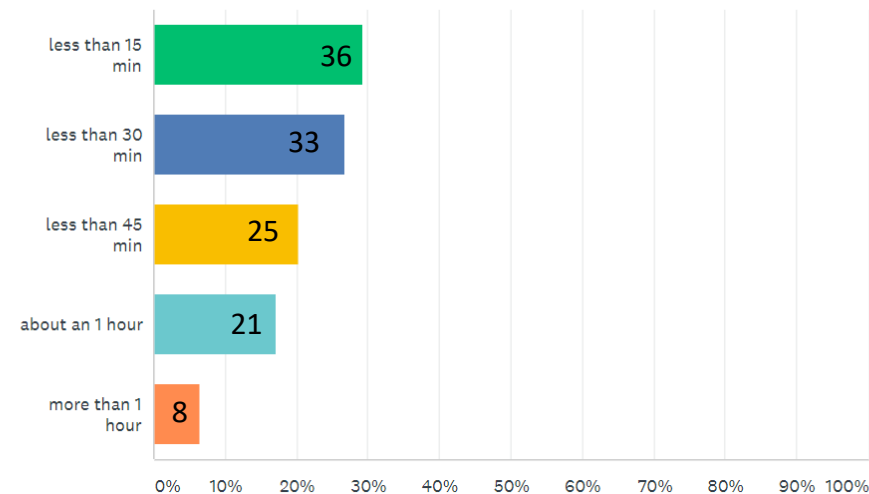
What means of transport do you use for your commute to Irchel Campus?
